COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX PROGRAM: Residents of Rothesay and Quispamsis are eligible to take advantage of a free preparation and electronic filing of basic income tax returns for the current or prior years. This service is available to single persons with an income limit of \$35,000 or a couple with an income limit of \$45,000. The clinic takes place every Tuesday from Mar 2nd to Apr 27th, 2021 from 9 am – 12 noon and 1 pm – 3 pm at St. Paul's Parish Centre, St. Paul's Anglican Church on the Rothesay Common. Due to Covid guidelines you must now drop off your information one Tuesday and pick up your completed return the following Tuesday. A Covid operational plan will be in effect.
