REMINDER: THE WALK 'N TALK SERIES WITH DAVID GOSS: Season 43 of this popular program began on June 22nd and like last year is subject to Covid restrictions: masks, social distancing, and pre-registration for all walks by contacting gosswalk@nbnet.nb.ca (or 672-8601) or others as noted prior to the event.
